Sub: Issue of entitlement of Privilege Pass/PTO

Large number of queries are pouring in AIRF Office on the issue of entitlement of Privilege Pass/PTO.

I agree that this issue has been delayed badly in spite of regularly pursuing by us. The issue has not only been discussed with the Adviser(IR), EDF(E), ED(Welfare), Railway Board but also with the Member Staff and Chairman, Railway Board not once but many a times.

Latest news on this issue is, I had drawn attention of the Member Staff, Railway Board on 10th March.

Today I had discussed the issue threadbare with the ED(Welfare), Railway Board, Shri Amitabh Khare, who has assured me that after studying the whole issue, he would make a proposal for onward submission to the Railway Board.

There are whispers in the corridors that the Finance is putting many hurdles in the name of numbers, occupancy and various other flimsy and imaginary issues.

We have again made it clear that AIRF is not going to change its stand from whatever had been agreed during Joint Committee meeting with the Adviser(IR), Railway Board, wherein it was very clearly agreed that all the staff working in Grade Pay Rs.4200 would be provided with First Class/2 AC pass, as has been given to other Central Government Employees, as well as those who are already availing this privilege should continue. The staff working in Grade Pay of Rs.2800 should be considered for 3 AC.

Anything latest in this regard will be explained will be explained you during AIRF Working Committee Meeting on 18-19 March, 2010.
