Sub : Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the 5th Central Pay Commission - grant of fixed Medical Allowance @ Rs.100/- per month to Railway Pensioners/Family Pensioners residing in areas not covered under C.G.H.S.

While a majority of Railway pensioners/Family Pensioners are governed under the specialised health care scheme of the Ministry of Railways, there are a few Railway Pensioners/Family Pensioners who are governed under Central Government Health Scheme administered by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

2. Instructions issued by the Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare vide their O.M. No. 45/57/97-P&PW(C) dated 19 December, 1997 on the above mentioned subject read alongwith all subsequent changes/modifications/clarifications etc., shall apply mutatis- mutandis to such Railway Pensioners/Family Pensioners also who are governed under the C.G.H.S.

3. CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972 correspond to Railway Services (Pension) Rules, 1993
