

IRTSA MEETING WITH SRI. RAJEN GOHAIN MOSR

23rd September, IRTSA delegate met Sri.Rajen Gohain Minister of State for Railways during his visit to Chennai. K.V.Ramesh, Sr.JGS/IRTSA requested to implement the directions of the Honb'le CAT Madras Bench given on 21st July 2016 in OA/706/2013 IRTSA Vs Union of India, wherein Ministry of Finance has been asked to consider and decide within a period of three months on the Office Memorandum No. PC VI/2009/DAC/1(pt2) dated 11.06.2010 of the Ministry of Railways for the approval of the proposal for enhancing the Grade Pay of Junior Engineers on Railways to at least higher than those of the Senior Technicians working under them, and enhancing the Grade Pay of Senior Section Engineers on Railways adequately above the Grade Pay of Junior Engineer and the Chief Office Superintendent working under them, as decided by the Departmental Anomalies Committee. A memorandum also submitted to MOSR. Sri.Gohain has agreed to discuss the issue with Member Staff.

He also handed over suggestions for improving Railway performance by 1) Providing 2 to 4 Cabins in existing A/C 2 Tier, A/C-3 Tier & Sleeper Coaches by providing lightweight Aluminium Doors in two or four bays of these coaches, 2) Manufacturing of Aluminium Car Body, Commodity transport facility for online marketing, etc, and 3) Utilisation of surplus space and capacity in IR Workshops like creation of logistic parks.
