Ref:- i) DOP O.M. F. No. 38/37/08-P&PW (A), dated 1.9.08 & _____

1. We extremely regret to bring to your kind notice the serious hardship being suffered by the Pensioners due to non-issue of Revised PPOs (Pension Pay Orders) by various Departments – in spite of issue of the order by the DOPT & P & PW (including the ones cited above).
2. At the same time some of the Banks are not charging the Additional Pension / Family Pension in case of those above 80 years of age - as & when they cross that age - especially where the DOB (Date of Birth) is not indicated in the earlier PPOs – even after submission of the age proof mentioned in the orders cited above.
3. Most of the Banks are not giving the correct amount of revised Pension & arrears thereof as per orders thereon – particularly in respect of Para 4.2 of DOP O.M. F. No. 38/37/08-P&PW (A), dated 1.9.08 & F.No. 38/37/08-P&PW (A) pt.1 dated 3. 10. 2008.
4. We sincerely feel that issue of revised PPOs is mandatory after every revision of Pension – as after a Pay Commission etc. It has become all the more essential in each case – especially after Sixth Pay Commission due to the element of Additional Pension introduced wef 1-1-06 for those of age 80 years & above as well due to other difficulties cited above particularly in respect of fixation under Para 4.2 of DOP O.M. F. No. 38/37/08-P&PW (A), dated 1.9.08, and clarifications there of and amendments / modifications issued in Revised Pay Rule 2008.
5. It is therefore requested that instructions may please be issued to all concerned to issue the Revised PPOs (Pension Pay Orders) to all pre – 2006 Pensioners at the earliest and Banks concerned be advised to charge the revised Pensions accordingly.
