**Subject :- Issue of separate Second Class Cheque
Passes to attendants.**

As the Railways are aware, separate second class cheque passes to the attendants of Railway Officers when not accompanying their employers either on duty or on Privilege Passes are issued as per provisions contained in Rule (xix) of [Schedule II](#) of Railway Servants Pass Rules, 1986. A doubt has arisen whether the said provisions will be applicable in cases where a separate pass for attendant is required to be issued on account of the fact that the train in which the officer is traveling does not have II class accommodation, e.g. Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express trains.

It is clarified that in such cases separate II class Cheque Passes to the attendants can be issued in respect of all passes in which an attendant is entitled to accompany the pass holders.

Note: The above instructions have been retreated in Part II Para 15 of commercial Circular No 16 of 2001 issued vide Rly Bd No 98/TG.I/9/P dated 29-03-2001
