**Railway Revenue Earnings up by 10.82 Per Cent During the Period 1st – 10th January
2011**

The total approximate earnings of Indian Railways on originating basis during the period from 1st to 10th January 2011 were Rs. 2511.59 crore compared to Rs. 2266.38 crore during the same period last year, registering an increase of 10.82 per cent.

The total goods earnings have gone up from Rs. 1582.90 crore during the period from 1st to 10th January 2010 to Rs. 1769.24 crore during 1st to 10th January 2011, showing an increase of 11.77 per cent. The total passenger revenue earnings during the period 1st to 10th January 2011 were Rs 656.61 crore compared to Rs. 598.92 crore during the same period last year, showing an increase of 9.63 per cent. The revenue earnings from other coaching amounted to Rs. 62.77 crore during this period compared to Rs. 63.36 crore during the same period last year, showing a decrease of 0.93 per cent.

The total approximate numbers of passengers booked during the period 1st to 10th January 2011 were 220.57 million compared to 208.86 million during the same period last year, showing an increase of 5.61 per cent. In the suburban and non-suburban sectors, the numbers of passengers booked during 1st to 10th January, 2011 were 126.61 million and 93.96 million compared to 119.73 million and 89.13 million during the same period last year, registering an increase of 5.75 per cent and 5.42 per cent respectively.
