A Committee consisting of following officers of Directorate General CRPF New Delhi was constituted for looking into the issue of working out ways and means to ensure that the best option for availing medical facilities under CGHS Scheme for NOKs of martyrs / deceased and superannuated force personnel is finalized :-

2. The Committee assembled in the chamber of IGP (Adm) Directorate on 24.4.2019. The following facts have emerged and decisions taken :-

i) As on date, CGHS facilities are available in 37 Cities across the Country for serving personnel who are posted there.

ii) CGHS facilities have also been extended to family members of serving CAPFs personnel who are transferred out from CGHS covered areas to J&K State and LWE affected areas, North Eastern Region and Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Lakshadweep.

iii) Consequent upon the revision of pay on the basis of implementation of the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission, Min. of Health and Family Welfare / GOI vide letter No. S.11011/11/2016-CGHS (P) / EHS dated 9.1.2017 revised the rates of subscriptions to be made by employees / pensioners, for availing benefits under CGHS wef. 1.2.2017 as per details given below:-

Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pensions and Pensioners Welfare vide letter No. F.No. 4/34/2017-P&PW(D) dated 31.1.2018 has issued necessary guidelines for grant of Fixed Medical Allowance to Central Government Civil Pensioners residing in areas covered / not covered under Central Government Health Scheme. The Ministry has also circulated a form for availing Medical Facilities under CGHS or availing Fixed Medical Allowance after retirement by choosing one of the following options which can be changed once in a lifetime.

3. It is evident that option No. (iv) ibid (in which both the provisions i.e. In-patient Department facility and drawing Fixed Medical Allowance for Rs. 1000/- per month for OPD treatment are available) is most beneficial for our Martyrs and Deceased Officers / Men who reside mostly in Non-

		(vii)	Avail medical facility of previous organization. <u>He/she will not avail CGHS facility and FMA.</u>

CGHS covered areas as against option (v) where they only avail a Fixed Medical Allowance of Rs. 1000 per month but do not get IPD treatment at CGHS empanelled hospitals.

4. Therefore, in order to provide CGHS facilities to all Martyrs/deceased and personnel who are proceeding on superannuation/Voluntary retirement, the modalities of deduction of CGHS contribution & preparation of CGHS cards to force personnel are as under:-

i) Option No. (iv) ibid wherein families of Martyrs and Deceased Officers / Men of CRPF who are residing in non-CGHS area are eligible to draw Fixed Medical Allowance of Rs. 1000/- per month and can also avail facility of In-door patient treatment by making lump sum payment of CGHS contribution (10 years subscription for life time facility) as per rank-wise rates discussed in Para 2 (iv) above, is found to be the most suitable option.

a) All Heads of office are requested to convince NOKs and family members of Martyrs / Deceased / other officers/men who are proceeding on Superannuation / Voluntary retirement and residing in non-CGHS

covered cities / areas to avail CGHS facilities in nearest covered cities by depositing lump – sum amount equal to 10 years subscription since this CGHS facility is more beneficial for all on long term basis as and when felt essential for getting referral for indoor treatment of serious ailments in CGHS empanelled hospitals with the progression of age- related ailments.

ii) The date of implementation of the scheme for the family members of Martyrs will be with effect from 01/01/2019 and for the family members of deceased Force personnel will be from the issue of these orders. Separate orders will be issued for payment of CGHS contributions for all martyrs of 2019 including Pulwama martyrs, whose Risk Fund Final Payments have already been made. Since, the Risk Fund Final Payments in respect of Martyrs/deceased Force personnel is being sent to Sector IsG (Adm) who further forward it to the nearest GCs for payment to the beneficiaries, therefore, it will be the responsibility of the nearest GC to deduct the CGHS contributions for family members of all martyrs / deceased Force personnel from the Risk Fund final payments and start process for preparation of CGHS cards in such a way that their CGHS cards should be delivered at their present home address. In case of any delay, Additional Director CGHS (HQ) in case of Delhi and Additional Director of city in case of other cities be contacted.

iii) As regard the date of implementation of scheme for the personnel who are proceeding on superannuation / voluntary retirement is concerned, the same will be with effect from 01/07/2019 as the Risk Fund Final payment of all such personnel who have proceeded / proceeding on superannuation/voluntary retirement upto May, 2019 have already been made. Since, the Risk fund final payment of personnel proceeding on superannuation / voluntary retirement is being made to the Unit/GC/office from where they have proceeded on superannuation / Vol. retirement, hence it will be the responsibility of the concerned unit/GC/office to deduct lump sum amount on account of CGHS subscription (i.e. 10 years subscription) from their Risk Fund Final payments and start process for preparation of CGHS cards and will ensure delivery of CGHS cards at their present home address.

iv) All the beneficiaries i.e. NOKs of Martyrs/deceased Force personnel and personnel proceeding on superannuation/voluntary retirement who are residing in a non-CGHS area but would be availing CGHS facility for IPD treatment only by payment of CGHS contribution in addition to availing fixed medical allowance for OPD treatment will submit their willingness for deduction of CGHS contribution from their Risk Fund Final Payments at the time of casualty. A format of such willingness/unwillingness to be given by the beneficiaries is enclosed.

v) The above arrangements will continue till the time they are ratified in the next Annual General Body Meeting of the Welfare Dte.

vi) As regards provision of CGHS facilities to the families of Martyrs / Deceased who have attained martyrdom / expired, all Heads of office are requested to find out present status of use / availability of CGHS cards by the NOKs as per list of such martyrs already provided to all concerned (Copy also enclosed for ready reference). GCOs and Nodal Officers detailed for martyrs are also requested to convince them of the utility of making life-time contribution to CGHS for their indoor treatment along with availing Fixed Medical Allowance, if they do not have CGHS cards. It may be explained to them how it is a much better option in the long term for any higher treatment at a CGHS empanelled hospital. The NOKs may be encouraged to exercise the one time change option and converting to the option of making one time contribution for the CGHS card for IPD treatment and availing Fixed Medical Allowance of Rs. 1000/- per month is more feasible. The same can be stressed upon for all NOKs of martyrs / deceased and the retirees on occasions like the Retirees & NOKs Sammelans in the GCs and through regular visits of Nodal Officers to them, use of bulk sms and through the CRPF Veer Pariwar Mobile App.

vii) As regards availing cashless treatment facilities by these force personnel is concerned, necessary referral slip of concerned CGHS dispensary is required for getting cashless treatment (IPD) of any CGHS empanelled hospitals.

viii) CGHS Forms can be downloaded from CGHS Website. They are also available in the office of Additional Director of the CGHS covered city (Additional Director Headquarter in case of Delhi).

ix) Following documents are required for preparation of CGHS Cards:-

- a) Application in prescribed format
 - b) Proof of residence
 - c) Proof of stay of dependents
 - d) Proof of age of son
 - e) Disability certificate, if any in case of sons aged 25 and above, who would otherwise cease to be a beneficiary.
 - f) Individual passport size photos of eligible family members.
 - g) Surrender Certificate of CGHS Card while in service (only in those cases where CGHS Card was issued while in service).
 - h) Attested copies of PPO and Last Pay Certificate.
 - i) Draft for required amount towards CGHS contribution - In the name of "P.A.O. CGHS New Delhi" in Delhi and in the name of "Additional Director, CGHS" of the city.
- x) If there is any change in residential address, CMO IC may be approached with proof of residence for transferring the data on line from one Wellness Centre to another in the same city. CMO IC of the new Wellness Centre will accept on line, the data of transferred cards.
